- Stations: After 10.00 am Mass each day during Lent
- Novena: with Benediction, Thursday 7.30 pm
- Confession: Thursday 7.00 pm; Saturday from 10.30 until 11.00 am and 6.20 until 7.00 pm
- Divine Mercy: Devotions on Monday at 7.00 pm
- Adoration: Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10.30 am until 8.00 pm and on Wednesdays from 10.30 am until 6.30 pm.
